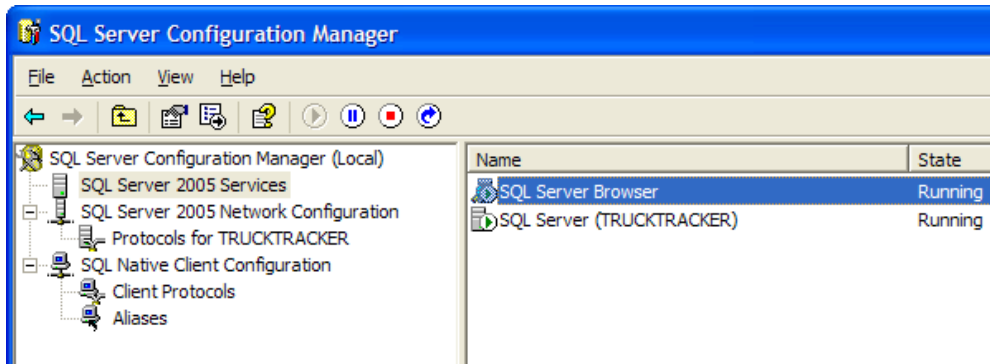


Changing the SQL Server Service Account

Changing the User Account of the SQL Server Service

When SQL Server performs operations on the file system, such as creating a backup file, the service needs to have file system permissions. It is recommended that you do not use the Administrator account for the service. You should create a new user account with only the permissions required by the service. To change the user account under which the SQL Server service is running, you need to go to the Windows Start Menu and select Microsoft SQL Server, Configuration Tools, and SQL Configuration Manager.



Right click on the SQL Server service for the instance used by Truck Tracker software and choose Properties (the default instance name is TRUCKTRACKER).
